Please note: the 6-month, 12 months, and 4-year appointments **MUST** be on or after the child turns that age.

What the abbreviations mean: **DTaP** - Diphteria, Tetanus, and Pertussis; **IPV** – Inactivated Polio; **HIB** – Haemophilus Influenzae; **MMR**- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella; **VZV** – Varicella; **HPV** – Human Papillomavirus (Gardasil); **TDaP** – Tetanus, Diphteria, and Pertussis.

MCV – Meningococcal ACWY (Menquadfi); **MCV B** – Meningococcal B (Bexsero)
